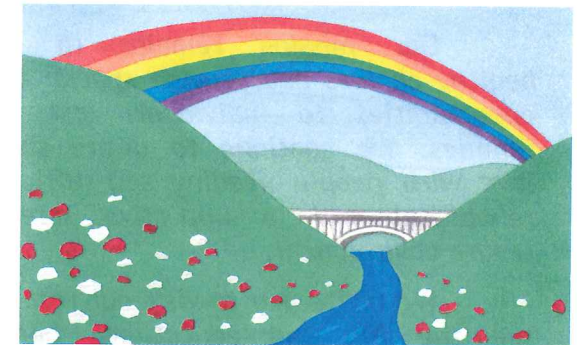

Frequently Asked Questions:

1-Does Medicaid pay for this service?

Answer: It depends upon the type of waiver by which your individual receives services or you may pay privately.

2-What are the hours of service?

Answer: We are open to whatever the need seven days a week. Short-term respite care including overnight.

3-Do you provide any other services?

Answer: We do Homemaker Personal Care, Day Habilitation, Vocational Habilitation, Day Camp (18 and under), short -term 24 hour respite, Adult Foster Care, Supportive Living, non-medical transportation and Safe Call.

4-What are some of the daily activities?

Answer: Medication monitoring or administration, housekeeping, escorting to appointments, shopping, events, and church, helping with personal care, self advocacy, meal preparation, crafts, exercise and behavioral support.
