INDIVIDUAL PROFILE

N is a 7 year old male who has been diagnosed with MR, Diabetes, Pervasive Developmental Delay, Autism, ADHD, Seizure disorder and is highly allergic to peanuts.

N is a loving child who is very close to his mom and sister. He enjoys playing with toys, games, video games and watching movies. He enjoys interaction with others and generally will follow along with “play” suggestions. He likes to have fun and stay busy, so it is very important to have an energetic provider.

It is important for the provider to know or be willing to learn how to test sugar levels as well as use an insulin pump. If the provider is watching N during a time that requires medication then the provider needs to be able to administer the medication as prescribed although his mom generally takes care of this need. N requires physical assistance when eating food, brushing his teeth, bathing and toileting so the provider will have to be willing to assist in these activities. It is also important for the provider to be aware of autism traits or be willing to learn.

The provider needs to be a loving individual and may be male or female, however N enjoys being around males and would interact great with a male figure. The provider for N must be a consistent provider who is willing to assist N at least two times per month on separate weekends. Mileage is included in his plan for community outings.
